LITERACY SKILLS

QUANTITATIVE SKILLS

I meet (or I plan to meet) the SFU Quantitative Skills Requirement in one of the following ways:

- achieve at least 60% in BC High School Grade 11 Principles of Mathematics, or its equivalent
- achieve a C- grade or higher in an acceptable college or university course, transferable to SFU as a certified quantitative (Q) course. (Most university-level mathematics and statistics courses and many other courses will satisfy this requirement.)
